



Der Weiße Ring - The race January 11 to 13, 2024

The most important race information at a glance:

- Every participant is obliged to collect the start number in person and to sign the General Terms and Conditions of Participation on site (photo ID must be presented).
- Discounted ski passes for participants for the race day are available without exception at the race number distribution point (€ 52 plus € 5 chip card deposit fee).
- Wearing a crash helmet (CE standard approved) is mandatory for all participants. Compliance with the helmet requirement will be checked at the start. It is also recommended to wear a back armor.
- Race numbers must be clearly visible during the race. Passing on the start number to other persons, as well as any modification of the official start number, in particular making the advertising imprint or the number number invisible or unrecognizable will also lead to disqualification.
- Passing through all gates is mandatory. Skipping gates will result in disqualification. In addition, some gates have a passage control by means of time measurement (these gates are not marked).
- The instructions of the marshals must be followed at all times. When the red flag is waved, the participants are obliged to stop IMMEDIATELY. When the yellow flag is waved, it is important to slow down sharply and continue driving with extreme caution so that it is possible to stop at any time. Failure to do so will result in result in disqualification!
- The conditions of carriage of the respective lift/tram must be observed and the instructions of the lift/tram staff must be followed immediately. Instructions of the lift/lane staff must be followed immediately.
- Results will only be announced and published at the award ceremony. The results lists can also be found on the Internet after the award ceremony.
- The certificates can be downloaded as PDF files from the homepage and then printed out.
- Photo service: Photos can be viewed and ordered online via the race homepage by entering the individual start number or can be viewed and ordered via www.sportograf.de.
- Free day parking is available in Lech at the Schlosskopf parking lot (prerequisite: valid day ski pass) or in Zürs next to the Trittkopfbahn. You can take the local bus to Lech. If these parking spaces are occupied parking spaces, please use the paid parking spaces in the Mühlegarage, Angergarage or Rüfigarage.

Saturday, January 13, 2024 - „Der Weiße Ring - Das Rennen“

- from 08:00 a.m.: Ascent with the Rüfikopfbahn (the Rüfikopfbahn is only for race participants, spectators without skis, press, etc.).
- The slopes from Rüfikopf to Zürs are closed until approx. 11:00 am due to the race. The Madloch is closed until approx. 12:00
- The slopes in the Kriegerhorn / Oberlech / Schlegelkopf area will also not be open during the race.
- 07:00 a.m. - 08:00 a.m.: Start number distribution (sport.park.lech, Strass 456, 6764 Lech): Distribution of starter packs
- from 8:00 am: Instructions for the athletes in the start area (Rüfikopf mountain station)
- from 9:00 am: Start of the 15th edition of „The White Ring - the race!“ The race starts every 10 seconds with 2 people.
- from 09:45: Arrival of the first racers at the finish (start numbers and time transponders will be collected immediately).
- from 10:00 am: catering available at the Dorfhüs
- 12:00 p.m.: Closing time
- approx. 13:00: award ceremony at the promenade behind the new Dorfhüs
- Afterwards: Numerous bars and restaurants in Lech Zürs are looking forward to surprising you with drinks & menus around „Der Weiße Ring - the Race“.
