



Der Weiße Ring - The Race

15. - 17. January 2026

The most important race information at a glance:

- Each participant is required to pick up their race number in person.
Race number pickup times: Friday 12 noon to 7 p.m. and Saturday 7 a.m. to 8 a.m. in the foyer on the 1st floor at Lechwelten
- Discounted ski passes for participants on race day are available without exception at the race number distribution point (€60 plus €5 chip card deposit fee).
- Wearing a helmet (CE-approved) is mandatory for all participants. Compliance with the helmet requirement will be checked at the start. Wearing back protection is also recommended.
- Race numbers must be worn in a clearly visible manner during the race. Passing on race numbers to other people or making any changes to the official race number, in particular making the advertising print or the number invisible or unrecognizable, will also result in disqualification.

The ten FIS rules of conduct apply and must be observed by all participants. Failure to comply will result in disqualification.

Passing through all gates is mandatory. Skipping control gates MAY result in disqualification. The race organizers reserve the right to add additional gates to the published course if snow, slope, and/or weather conditions require it.

When the marshal waves the yellow flag and/or blows the whistle, participants must drive with extreme caution (ready to brake) and follow the instructions of the track personnel. Participants must adapt their driving style to the fact that several drivers are using the same track at the same time. When the red flag is waved and/or a whistle signal, participants are required to stop immediately and follow the instructions. Failure to comply will result in disqualification.

- The conditions of carriage for the respective lift/railway must be observed and the instructions of the lift/railway personnel must be followed immediately.
- Datasport provides a live ticker for the event. The final results will be announced and published at the award ceremony. The results lists will also be available on the internet after the award ceremony.
- The certificates can be downloaded as PDF files from the homepage and then printed out.
- Photo service: Pictures can be viewed and ordered online via the race homepage by entering the individual start number or via www.sportograf.de.
- Free day parking is available in Lech at the Schlosskopf car park (requires a valid day ski pass) or in Zürs next to the Trittkopfbahn cable car. You can get to Lech by local bus. If these car parks are full, please use the paid parking spaces at the Mühle, Anger, or Rüfi car parks.

Saturday, January 17, 2026 - „Der Weiße Ring- The Race“

- 7:00 a.m. - 8:00 a.m.: Race number distribution at Lechwelten, Dorf 100
- from 8 a.m.: Ascent with the Rüfikopfbahn (the Rüfikopfbahn is only for race participants, spectators without skis, press, etc.). Instructions for the athletes in the start area (Rüfikopf mountain station)
- from 9 a.m.: Start of the 20th edition of „Der Weiße Ring – The Race!“ The race starts every 10 seconds with 2 people. Access is only possible 1 hour before your personal start time.
- from 09:45: Arrival of the first racers at the finish (start numbers and time transponders will be collected immediately).

The slopes from Rüfikopf to Zürs are closed until approx. 11 a.m. due to the race. The Madloch is closed until approx. 12:00. Some slopes in the Kriegerhorn / Oberlech / Schlegelkopf area will also not be open during the race.

- approx. 1 p.m.: award ceremony at the Rüfiplatz
